To whom it may concern,

The Peace River Regional Cattlemen's Association and Peace River Forage Association have recently partnered with Shifting Mosaics Corporation, Northern Fire WoRx Corp., Arras Fire Brigade and Hudson's Hope Fire and Rescue to increase knowledge and safety of wildland fire in the Peace. We are hosting two Wildland Fire Schools in the Peace for 14 participants in each session. Courses offered include: ICS100, S100 and S185 supplemented with field components. Eight seats are available for local Indigenous Community members who are interested in a career in wildland fire.

Pre-registration is required, and a waitlist will be established in case additional seats become available.
