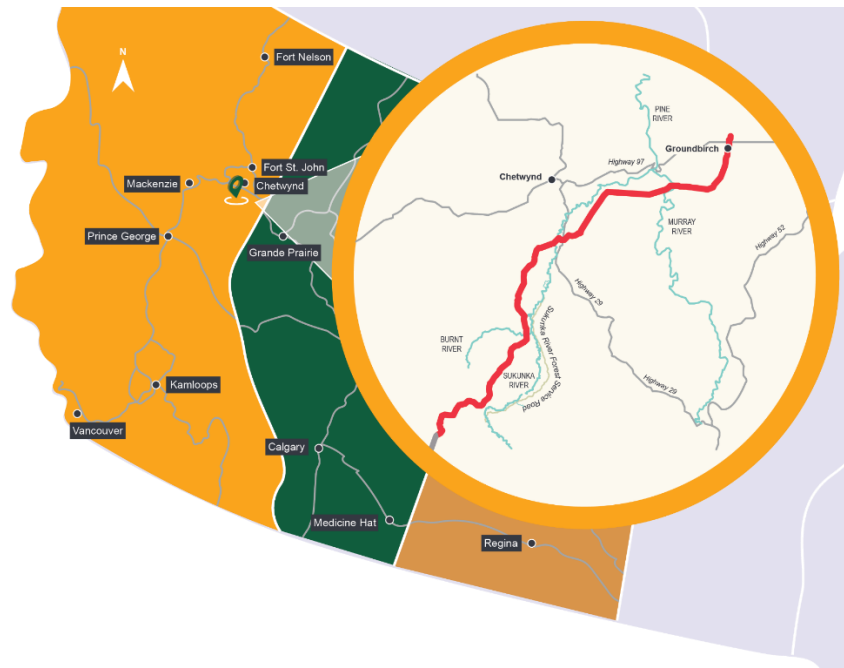


Coastal Gas Link Project – Sections 1 & 2

SMJV is constructing 140 kms of 48-inch diameter pipe for the Coastal Gas Link Project, we have completed over 100kms to date. We will be completing our fourth and final season of mainline installation from June to October 2022 and are self-performing most of the work ourselves, and we will peak at approximately 700 personnel in mid-July. All crews will begin to decrease in October with the tentative mainline completion in December 2022. Minimal crews will return to complete final clean up in Summer 2023.
