- If you do not have a valid CIS or SCIS card available, any other valid government issued identification which has your signature is
 acceptable. A photocopy of both sides must be included with the form.
- If requesting payment on behalf of minors in your custody for whom you are the legal guardian, provide a photocopy of proof of guardianship.
- Individuals who are 18 or older must complete their own payment request form. To request payment on behalf of dependents that are 18 or older, please include proof of guardianship with the form.
- · A single lump-sum payment of the combined annuity amounts owed to all individuals listed on this form will be issued to applicant.
